

*** RULE - GO-PEDS**

1. No Go-Ped may be operated between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
2. No Go-Ped is to exceed 10 miles per hour (mph) within the Association
3. The Operator of the Go-Ped must:
 - a. be at least 14 years of age;
 - b. have written permission from the owner of the Go-Ped before driving the Go-Ped;
 - c. wear shoes that completely cover the feet and toes;
 - d. wear a helmet if under the age of 18 years of age;
 - e. wear eye protection
4. A Go-Ped cannot be operated:
 - a. on private Association Roadways without written permission from the Board of Directors;
 - b. after dusk without a headlamp visible from at least 500 feet and a rear reflector;
 - c. if it has been structurally altered, including altering the fuel reservoir; and
 - d. without adequate brakes (the Go-Ped must be able to skid on pavement)
5. Operator of a Go-Ped must:
 - a. obey all city and state traffic laws;
 - b. ride as far to the right as practical on the roadway, except when preparing to make a left turn
6. Operator of a Go-Ped cannot:
 - a. transport passengers;
 - b. cling to other vehicles;
 - c. carry an article which prevents keeping both hands on the handlebars;
 - d. ride side-by-side with more than one other motorized skateboard; and
 - e. transport extra fuel.

*** RULE - DISPLAY OF HOLIDAY DECORATIONS**

All Holiday Decorations may be put on display two weeks prior to the recognized holiday to be celebrated and shall be removed from display two weeks after the recognized holiday. The only exception to the above two week pre and post holiday display period is for the New Years Holiday celebration. The New Year holiday celebration decorations may be displayed from Thanksgiving until January 31st of the New Year. There should be no colored lights except during these holiday times.
